1. New Proposals, Extension Request or Final Report Presentations.

a. Final report presentation, "Yakama River Beaver Project", Mel Babik, MCFEG.

Mel and William presented a power point presentation based on the questions Rick sent them after reading their final report. They did a good job quantifying their results as best they could. They emphasized that quantifying the results are difficult because beavers and beaver colonies are pretty dynamic. Success is evaluated based on the number of relocated animals still present after a year. They also made it clear that the literature is clear on the benefits of beaver colonies for fish so they didn't feel the need to confirm that preferring to put that energy toward colony creation. There were enough committee members present to vote in favor of accepting the final report and this presentation as meeting the final report requirements.

b. Wallowa River-Baker Salmonid Habitat Restoration Project, Colleen Fagan, ODFW

Erick began his presentation of this preliminary proposal by highlighting how it satisfies all of our criteria. The proposal intends to restore an old side channel that meanders through an alfalfa field. The project includes 30 acres around the side channel and a 15 year easement/agreement disallowing crop production or grazing. The area would be fenced, log structures would be added and lots of seedlings planted. They anticipate movement of the channel, increased complexity and increased fish production. Brandon asked if there would be flow in it at low flows. They said during all but the driest years. Rick asked if they were concerned about stream movement destroying plantings or going outside easement boundaries. They said they were concerned but would evaluate if and when that happened and decide then if the project was still meeting its goals. RD asked about fish production expectations and if that information would be in a full proposal. They said there would be some of that in the full proposal. There was some discussion of this being phase 1 of a larger project and how there were other projects working on different sections of the same river.

RD suggested that they we may want to let them know that the Committee did not care to fund design work so they could avoid requested changes in fund allocation. Erick said they had done that and Colleen added that the Engineering money in the budget was for on site work supervision by an engineer, not design work.

There was an interest in giving them our decision today so we voted and got enough votes to ask them to submit a full proposal.
