1. New Proposals/Extension Request

a. Mid-Columbia Fisheries Enhancement Group- Beaver Relocation Project end date extension request. Margaret Neuman and Melisa Babik from Mid-Columbia Fisheries Enhancement Group were present to present results from 2014 and request a one year extension on their grant to use the remaining funds. Melissa went through a PP presentation and discussed number of beavers relocated in 2014 (35), she talked about success rate in 2013, which was 50% of beavers relocated still in place and building structures. She wrapped it up by stating the goals for 2015 which were to relocate 10-15 beavers, improve methods, monitor success and present results. They anticipate having about \$35K left over and they believe that with increased volunteer help, remaining funds in other grants, and other savings, they will have enough money to accomplish their goal.

There was some talk of measuring success or at least effect of beavers, because after all we aren't interested in more beavers, we are interested in more fish. The consensus was that it is well established that beaver habitat can benefit fish which justifies continued beaver dispersal.

After the presentation and Mel and Margaret had left, a short discussion was followed by a vote which was unanimous in favor of granting the extension.

2. August 12 meeting minutes and August 26th conference call minutes approval.

Gary requested that one line in the discussion about impacts of the McNary turbine be changed. Rick will make the change and send to Gary for concurrence. If the change is satisfactory, the minutes will be approved and added to the website.

This question had morphed into a change form by the meeting time so the change form was considered. It was agreed that some language was needed in the protocols and on the GAD. The GAD does stipulate that a report is due no later than 60 days after the end date on the GAD. Dave thought reimbursement requests deadline should match that. He also mentioned that the language Julie had emailed sounded good. Others had not seen that yet. So, Rick said he would look at what Julie submitted and make a revised change form for folks to consider before changes would be made. Until this is resolved, this issue will be handled on a case by case basis.

Dave said he would like to see river miles on the maps and more data.

Erick Vandyke and Bob Rose joined the meeting via conference line at about this point in the meeting.

Erick said he remembered a similar reaction to their first report.

Bob questioned how the data would be used, which Gary said should be our first question.

Dave added that he would like to see an appendix with the PIT tag codes used.

Rick suggested we all take some time and read through the report, generate any questions you have, send them to Rick who will combine into one letter, send that out for review, and then send the final version to WDFW.
